Mission



- Brief bio for each presenter, 150 words maximum (in foot note)
- 🔹 Title
- Solution Abstract of 250 words maximum
- The extend of articles should be between 10 and 20 pages (font Ariel, 12, 1,5 spacing)

Articles are accepted online from March 1, 2022 by filling in the information as required above. Participants also must register online by filling in the registration form.
